Guest Speaker-Christina Lokke, California Special Districts Association A presentation was given on various legislative updates of interest to local special districts. Handouts included the CSDA Grassroots Action Brief and Legislative Hot Sheet-Summer Recess Addition.

a. Legislative Chair Report-Vince Ferrante *Report was given on Legislative Days at State Capitol.*

b. Finance Committee Chair-Paul Ingram

Reviewed financial spreadsheet and acknowledged reserves after income and expense. Reminded by Clerk Paula Riso that a minimum balance of \$2,500 must be maintained in order to receive no fee account. Discussion on finances with regard to approximately \$500needed to maintain liability insurance in order to become a CSDA chapter. Discussion of bringing in additional funds for this cost by raising quarterly dinner meeting cost. It was pointed out that some attendees are not reimbursed by their districts for dinner costs and raising that cost would burden those attendees most. Discussion was held regarding possible dues to each member district as a way to raise additional funds for liability insurance and other costs. At the October 21^{st} meeting a vote could be taken to send a ballot to member districts to create the needed dues structure. Amount will be decided at that meeting.

Carl Miller has researched a liability policy from Gails Creek Insurance Services. A MOTION [Jeffries] 2nd [Snodgrass] to approve \$440.00, plus a \$75 set-up fee, to purchase this policy, carried unanimous. Insurance will be paid as of 9/1/2014.
