SDAMC Minutes October 17, 2017

- 1. President Warren "Pete" Poitras called the meeting of the Special Districts Association of Monterey County (SDAMC) to order at 6 pm.
- 2. Self-introductions were made followed by the dinner buffet and guest speakers.
- 3. Invited speaker: Senator Bill Monning Senate Majority Leader:

State Senator Bill Monning summarized the 2017 Legislative session including \$1.5 million in the state budget for Phase II construction of the Veteran Cemetery in Fort Ord and \$24 million for the Highway One Pfeiffer Canyon Bridge project, a project that would usually take 7 years that was completed in 7 months. The Highway One Mud Creek landslide repairs in southern Monterey County should be complete next August. The budget was balanced for the 7th year in a row. Two bond measures were approved for the November 2018 ballot that if passed would provide \$4 billion for affordable housing and \$5 billion for State Parks. SB1 was passed increasing the gas tax to provide an additional \$5 billion per year for transportation infrastructure increasing the average monthly gas bill by \$5. Electric cars will ultimately pay an additional \$100 per year registration fee. The \$127 billion California budget supports a \$2 trillion economy that would be the 5th largest country in the world. Senator Monning reported the primary sources of revenue for the state are Personal Income, Sales, Capital Gains and Corporate taxes. All of the revenue sources are volatile based on the condition of the economy as evidenced by the last recession in 2008 when state revenue reduced by 30% from \$100 billion to \$70 billion. The governor insisted on a reserve or rainy day fund currently containing \$10 billion.

In response to questions, Senator Monning indicated he does not yet have a position on the future of the Fort Ord Reuse Authority which is required to have a transition plan completed by 2018.

4. Chris Palmer, CSDA Update:

Mr. Palmer, from the California Special Districts Association (CSDA) Member Services Team, reported on Legislative issues related to special districts. Our local Director and current CSDA President Vince Ferrante reported attendance of 825 for the recent CSDA conference in Monterey.
