The Special Districts Association of Monterey County (SDAMC) met on July 17, 2018 at the Shoreline Community Center in Marina.

The topic of the presentation was groundwater sustainability management. Speakers were Keith Van Der Maaten, General Manager of Marina Coast Water District (MCWD) and Gary Petersen, General Manager of Salinas Valley Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency (SVGSA). The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act was approved in 2014 and required a local Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) be formed by June, 2017 and Groundwater Sustainability Plans (GSP) be prepared by 2020 for high priority basins and by 2022 for the rest of the basins. The GSP is required to show how the basins can reach sustainability within 20 years. The local GSA will have authority to restrict pumping, collect fees and adopt rules but will not determine water rights. SVGSA was formed to control 6 sub-basins of the Salinas River and each requires a separate GSP. MCWD will act as the GSA for the Monterey sub-basin generally located within the district boundaries. The state provided \$1 million to MCWD and \$1.5 M to SVGSA. The focus is now on collecting well data and hydrogeological models required for the preparation of the GSP. The key local issue is how to address seawater intrusion below the Salinas River basin and there are no current seawater intrusion models. Gary Petersen shared observations by state officials that the process is like building an airplane while you fly. Another pearl from Gary – Many people live without love but no one lives without water.

California Special Districts Association (CSDA) Legislative analysist Anthony Tannehill reported on Legislative issues and focused on the propositions on the November ballot. He reported a proposition that would have severely impacted local government funding was pulled after an agreement for legislation requiring no soda tax for 12 years. CSDA is supporting Proposition 3, a water bond for projects not covered by the recently passed Proposition 68. CSDA is opposing Proposition 5 which would allow more Prop 13 portability and could curtail up to \$100 million in local government property tax increases.

Kate McKenna, Executive Director of the Local Agency Formation Commission of Monterey County (LAFCO), reported public hearings are set for the August meeting to review annexations for North County Fire Protection District and Monterey County Regional Fire District in areas north of Marina and an agreement between Marina Coast Water District and Seaside County Sanitation District related to service boundary issues. Joe Serrano reported LAFCO is working with the Fort Ord Reuse Authority on a transition plan for the dissolution process.

The next SDAMC meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, October 16, 2018 at 6:00 pm at the Shoreline Conference Center in Marina.
