# Meeting Minutes: October 16, 2018 Special Districts Association of Monterey County

The Special Districts Association of Monterey County (SDA) met on October 16, 2018 at the Shoreline Community Center in Marina.

Assembly Member Mark Stone made a presentation indicating the legislature is currently out of session and waiting for the new governor. He reported the state is in good financial shape with the largest budget ever adopted including the largest reserve. He believes the change in term limits that allows members to serve in one house up to 12 years has provided some stability and allowed more consideration of long-term issues. He reported on a new phenomenon of ballot measures being used to leverage legislation that otherwise might not pass. The primary example is a proposition supported by the soda industry, that would have severely impacted local government funding, was pulled after an agreement for legislation requiring no new taxes on soda for 12 years.

Monterey County Registrar of Voters Claudio Valenzuela made the second presentation indicating the current 186,000 registered voters is the highest total ever. There were only 13 people in Monterey County improperly registered by the Department of Motor Vehicles. They are expecting a high voter turnout similar to the 83% rate in 2008 and 73% of voters submit mail ballots. His department has 12 fulltime employees that increases to include several hundred temporary employees during the election season. His department receives \$4.2 Million from the County general fund and elections costs are reimbursed by the agencies that have contested elections. The total cost of an election is about \$6 to \$8 per voter or about \$1 M. Costs include temporary workers for polling locations, printing and mailing costs for 117 different books in two languages. He added state and federal agencies contribute nothing for the cost of the election.

California Special Districts Association (CSDA) President Neil McCormick is soliciting input for issues of concern for the next legislative session. He also reported CSDA is hiring another field representative so that each region will have its own coordinator.

Kate McKenna, Executive Director of the Local Agency Formation Commission of Monterey County (LAFCO), reported working with the Fort Ord Reuse Authority (FORA) staff and Senator Monning on developing a transition plan that would assign all assets, responsibilities and liabilities to successor agencies when FORA sunsets in two years. FORA still wants legislative changes to extend the sunset date another 10 years and give LAFCO more responsibility to assign duties to successor agencies. Joe Serrano reported LAFCO is also requesting information from agencies providing Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services on a countywide level.

Jeff Froke agreed to serve with Carl Miller and Pete Poitras on the nominating committee for the 2019 SDA officers. The next SDA meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 15, 2019 at 6:00 pm at the Shoreline Conference Center in Marina.
